Khan is a supplement, not a curriculum, and is not accredited. It does not cover handwriting, deep writing instruction, fine arts, PE, music, or project work. Mastery on Khan is a useful signal — not a grade.

Setup checklist

- ☐ **Step 1.** Create a parent account at [khanacademy.org/signup](https://www.khanacademy.org/signup).
- ☐ **Step 2.** Add the Teacher role from your account settings to unlock the Teacher Dashboard.
- ☐ **Step 3.** Create a class and add your child(ren) with usernames you control.
- ☐ **Step 4.** Assign the Grade 5 math course (use FL B.E.S.T. version in Florida).
- ☐ **Step 5.** Bookmark Reading & Vocab, Grammar, and the Parent Dashboard.

Daily math workflow

- ☐ **1.** GD math lesson + direct instruction (15–20 min).
- ☐ **2.** Khan video for the same skill if a second voice helps.
- ☐ **3.** Khan exercise set, mastery threshold 80% (15–20 min).
- ☐ **4.** Log time on GD Subject-Hours Tracker (Template 2B).
- ☐ **5.** Mark the standard on the GD Standards Coverage Matrix (2D).

Quarter-by-quarter plays

- ☐ **Quarter 1:** Place value, decimals, and add/subtract fractions — Khan unit assessments mirror GD Q1 math benchmarks.
- ☐ **Quarter 2:** Multi-digit multiplication & division + Q2 Mastery Challenges; Vocab Unit 2; punctuation review.
- ☐ **Quarter 3:** Fraction multiplication/division + volume; layer Reading & Vocab thematic units beside GD novels.
- ☐ **Quarter 4:** Coordinate plane + properties of shapes + unit conversion; mastery sweeps before the GD year-end final.

Where it fits in your toolkit

GD = the spine. Khan = additional practice, alternative explanations, and mastery tracking — strongest for math, ELA grammar, and vocabulary.
