SOCIAL STUDIES

Students select their three strongest artifacts representing the diverse cultures of the Western Hemisphere to begin their capstone portfolio assembly.

Materials & Prep

- world map / hemisphere map

MATH

Students map out the dimensions of their final presentation boards using coordinate grids to plan the layout of their data visualizations (5.G.A.2).

ELA

Students write a thematic reflection on Esperanza's journey in 'Esperanza Rising' to serve as the introduction for their year-end portfolios (RL.5.2).

- vocabulary log
- writing notebook

SCIENCE

Groups organize seasonal shadow length data collected throughout the year to create final graphs showing the Earth's orbit around the sun (5-ESS1-2).

Materials & Prep

- science notebook
- pencil
- lab safety reminder
- graph paper / coordinate grid
- flashlight + globe / sun-Earth-Moon model
