SOCIAL STUDIES

Students synthesize their knowledge of the U.S. Constitution and the Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms for a comparative government display.

Materials & Prep

- world map / hemisphere map
- social studies notebook
- primary source excerpt
- Constitution excerpt copies

MATH

Students calculate the total area of their showcase booth space and determine the coordinate points for each display item (5.G.A.2).

Materials & Prep

- math notebook
- pencil + eraser
- scratch paper
- graph paper / coordinate grid

ELA

Working in pairs, students peer-edit Year 5 reflection letters that use sensory details and precise language to recount their favorite classroom moments (W.5.3).

Materials & Prep

- anchor text or copies
- vocabulary log
- writing notebook

SCIENCE

The class creates a collaborative timeline of the year's astronomical observations to illustrate the predictable pattern of the stars' positions (5-ESS1-2).

- science notebook

- lab safety reminder
- flashlight + globe / sun-Earth-Moon model
